#### 187) Items for City Councillors

The Councillors Surgery last Saturday morning was quite busy. Items discussed includes the Local Plan, Eyebury Road and passing places in the High Street. Officers will be asked to look at these.

The trenches currently being excavated on land opposite Oxney Grange is not in the Eye Parish but is believed to be an archaeology investigation for a new access road in the area.

The new shop causing concern with children buying vapes is being looked at by Trading Standards and PCC Officers are aware.

The lights at the skate park are not on – will be reported again.

Road signs are being left once roadworks are completed.

Waiting for update from Aragon as to when the vegetation at the Oxney Grange S bends will be cut back.

Clothing Bank, Luke's Lane, is sited on PCC land without permission. Fly tipping is regularly left around it. The bank is to be removed.

Community Leadership Fund - £9,000 between the 3 Ward Councillors and the 3 villages of Eye, Thorney & Newborough. This fund now runs each calendar year.

Neighbourhood police are meeting Ward councillors next week in the villages – The Parish Council expressed disappointment that they were not informed nor invited to attend.

Mud on Whitepost Road – still in the middle of the roadway.

The asbestos issue in Back Lane – the Parish Council haven't been updated on actions taken. The roof on the premises has now had tiles put over the asbestos.

Believed that PCC couldn't find where the asbestos had gone to, the Parish Council to be told if anyone has been fined and how much – would act as a deterrent.

82 High Street, planning consent given, mature tree has been removed. PCC Tree Officer/Planning Enforcement to be asked about the replacement trees.

Old Rectory building work – clerk to make enquiries.

Scrutiny Committee now have a meeting in January to discuss Eye Youth Club.

The Chair and Vie-Chair met reps from Glinton and Northborough Football Club who have expressed an interest in playing their games at Lindisfarne Road. They would have to provide all their own equipment and storage facilities, do the line marking etc and liaise with Eye Juniors who currently play down there. They would not be provided with keys initially and would rent the building at the current rate for non-local teams.

To look into grants for putting 2 floodlights on the front of the building looking over the field.
